You will need to check your child's supplies against the packaging list prior to leaving the school. Parents may choose to leave book packs at the school where they will be delivered to your child's room. Alternatively you can take the book pack home but must send **the whole pack** back to school (named and labelled) with your child/children on the **first day of school**, Thursday 28th January 2021.
